I arranged with our Mission Chaplain to take these pictures & asked him to do them in the usual way but evidently he thought it undelicate to dispense with their pants. Next time I go to the Station I will borrow his camera & take these two men myself.

& Cooydon. How old Heby will
chorde .. I ^{shd} like much to see

by any means an unhappy time
at Normanton but I feel rather
ashamed to think that we didn't
have a shot at the blacks there
