Mrs. W. J. Kell, who died at College Park on Sunday, at the age of 74, was born in Liverpool, England. She came to Australia as a young woman, and was for some time a nurse in the Adelaide Hospital. She was transferred to Burra, and then went to Darwin as matron of the hospital there. Mrs. Kell, after rendering valuable service in that institution, continued her duties at Powell's Creek, where she met her husband, Mr. Walter James Kell, who was postmaster there. Mrs. Kell while at Powell's Creek was the only white woman in that district. After a visit to Adelaide Mrs. Kell accompanied her husband to Wallaroo, where Mr. Kell was postmaster. He died in that town six years ago. For the last three years of her life, Mrs. Kell lived with friends at Glenelg. A sister, Miss Birkett, resides in Sydney.
