Dear Sir,

We beg to thank you sincerely for your kind letter of the 19th inst., in reference to the machine which we were privileged to supply General Pitt Rivers some time since. We are glad to learn that its working has on the whole been satisfactory, though our previous experience had led us to hope that no difficulties of any kind would have arisen.

With regard to that which you mention, the tendency of the paper to slip in taking a number of copies, we would suggest that this is probably due to the fact that the rubber bands round the paper feed roll have become weakened by use or greasy with oil, as this mishap never occurs if our instructions are followed under ordinary circumstances. Or the slipping might be caused by one or both of the envelope holders pressing too tightly against the cylinder. This can be obviated by loosening the top screws of one or both of the envelope holders so that the small wheels at the end thereof would only just

be touching the paper round the rubber cylinder. The defect is however probably due to the first cause. Should you, after carrying out this suggestion, find that the paper still fails to keep straight we shall be glad to have the opportunity of seeing the machine, so as to ensure its working altogether to your satisfaction.
