My dear Sir,

Thanks for your letter
which I only received out here.
I cannot give here the details of the
E.R.A. subscribers; but roughly
we have £150 promised from an
American University, £50 given
from Miss Edwards' estate, help from
£5 subscribers, & the rest £142
subscribers. Making altogether about
£300 received or due this year. For
the two men at present here I could
well utilize £500 this season, but we
can float on £300, though with
difficulty.

I am much obliged for your suggestion
about models; and as I am going to
clear out an entire part of the
XVIIIth quantity we might well have

a model of that to enlighten the
public, somewhat like the model
of Pompeii at Naples.

I am hoping to get somewhat of
early times from two large
masses of desert stones, & a
ruined pyramid of early
construction, over here.
