# ST. ANDREW'S CHURCH,

MELCOMBE HORSEY.

THIS work which, at a meeting held in February, 1894, was considered to be a great and immediate necessity, is now nearly completed, and has been most carefully carried out by Messrs. Merrick and Sons, Glastonbury, under the superintendence of Mr. Evelyn Hellicar, Architect, 10 Sergeants' Inn, Fleet Street, E.C.

The total cost of the work of restoration will amount to £850, of which £570 have been given and promised. The parish being small and situated in an entirely agricultural district, it is naturally difficult to raise so large a sum of money in the neighbourhood, but the committee are most grateful to those who have already given them their kind support, and they trust that this second appeal may result in the remainder of the money being subscribed, in order that they may be able as soon as possible to free the Church of debt.
