these parts.

chamber as I have everything  
ready in the way of plans sections  
photographs &c especially after  
the Blackguard way in which I  
have been treated by the man

who didn't turn up until 2  
months after I had been at  
work, and wouldn't then have  
done so had he not thought  
that something was to be got
