

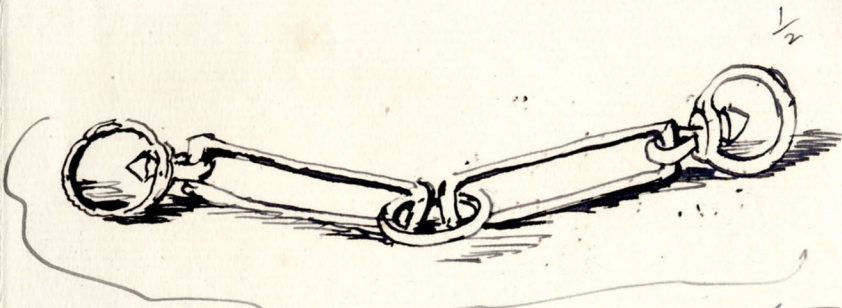
Dorchester. Feb. 11. 1895 (L1174)

A couple of months ago
Mr. Cree, Over-wigge, gave
to the Museum here a short
chain, which is described and
slightly sketched over leaf.
He thinks that it is the chain
of a mormale, and to myself
too this seems likely.

He has written to Sir A. Franks
who says that, in the absence
of any ornamental detail,
he cannot give the date of
the chain. He refers Mr. Cree
to you as more able to speak
about this chain than myself.
