This material is used by about
 17 or 18 houses & is of no
 use to the people in other
 parts of the Parish, & thus
 it would be a great injustice
 to make the duty of the Parish
 pay for it. What they
 want is to have the wall
 round the well rebuilt
 & a windlass & bucket
 fixed to the opening of
 the well enlarged. I think
 50/- besides the Carpenter
 & masons work, will pay the
 debt & thus save something like
 50/- which of 3 years would
 produce 100/- plus of which these
 men would find some means

of the Parish
