forward at the B. Assn.

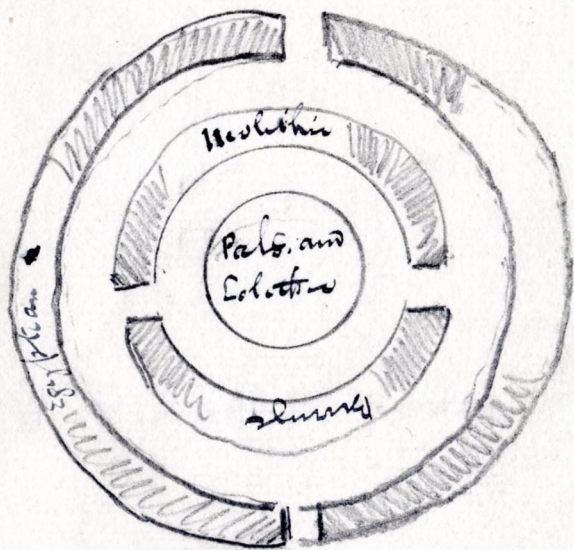
It so happened yesterday I was
