Dearest Papa.

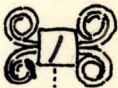

I am afraid I have very little  
room in our boxes for putting  
things, they are very heavy as it  
is. We leave here next Thursday  
the 26<sup>th</sup> and go to Chamonix.

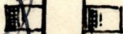
The air here is lovely and I feel
