Dear Mr. Mansel-Pleydell,

In answer to your letter of yesterday, my views on theological and ecclesiastical matters are very much the same as those of Dr. Vaughan, Dean of Landaff and late Master of the Temple, whose voluminous writings are well-known. I was brought up among the broader-minded Evangelical Churchmen (of whom my father was one), but during the last fifteen years my views have widened out considerably, and are I suppose what would be called Broad Church. With Romanizing

tendencies in the Ch. of E. I have no sympathy; or rather, I am strongly opposed to them.

It is only fair under the circumstances that I should give the names of one or two references: the Rev. Canon Dyke, Compton Abbas Rectory, Shaftesbury, for whom I have often done duty, and the Rev. Dr. Cunningham Geikie (Old Park, Bournemouth) a well-known Broad Church writer ("The Life of Christ", "Hours with the Bible," &c.) would I am sure answer any reasonable question about me.
