Dear Sir

I am compiling matter for a work chiefly upon the early earthworks of England, taking also those earthworks such as Abury, Stonehenge, Arborlow etc which combine earth and stone remains, and more or less anything throwing light on British and other works.

I propose coming into Wiltshire to compare the remains there again more in detail.

One special hope I have is to publish ground plans of most of the fortified places, especially those not generally known such as

Bolsover, Pleshey etc which like Rotherley and Woodcuts Common need rescuing from oblivion.

This reminds me, is it possible to get copies of your ground plans of Rotherley & Woodcuts such as appear in your excavations?

If you can help me in any way by telling me of any earthworks in obscure places, that are not "planned," I shall be exceedingly obliged, either in Wiltshire for work now, or in any part of England for future investigation.
