You may remember that I wrote to you some time ago saying that I was going to plant along the line of a dyke on Fore Top, Fortnook Down. The soil in the ditch did not seem to have been moved for more than

nine inches, or a foot, except
at one place, where about
3 feet down the men found
the bits of pottery and bone
which I forward to you.

I went to the place on Friday,
and made them clear out
the more ground about
2 feet more, till they came

anyone to look at it, before
filling in, do not trouble to
return the fragments —
I trust you are better I did
not hear a very good
account of you, some little
time back.
