I find that I was mistaken in thinking the Poleswell ornament more intricate than that from Bagber.

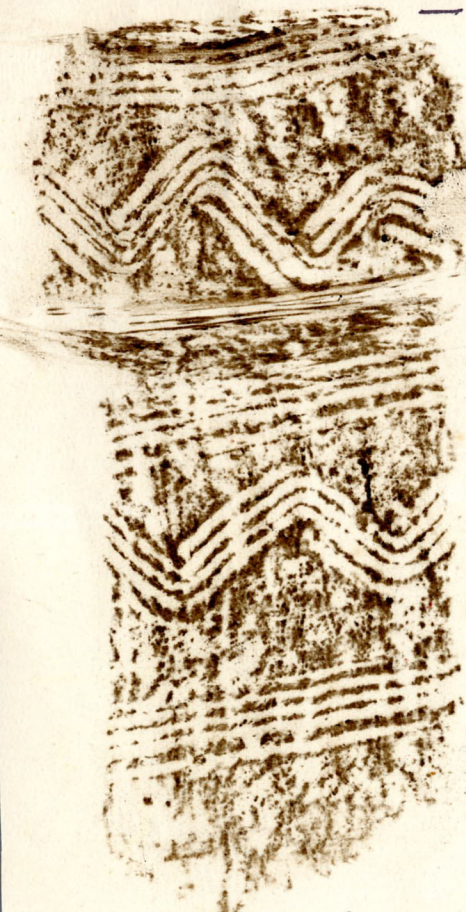
Both were are of the same class, no shape, and in quality of work.
