the fracture in the wall.

You will use the iron
straps. The new roof
can be made suffic-
iently strong. I have
no doubt. without struts
by doing a few little
matters at trifling
cost while the men are
putting on the roof -
this roof would have
been much better
had there been two
purlins instead of

me. If you wish

put on. I should like
to know, & I would probably
be able to come over
about the 12th of June
when there will be
more for me to see.
