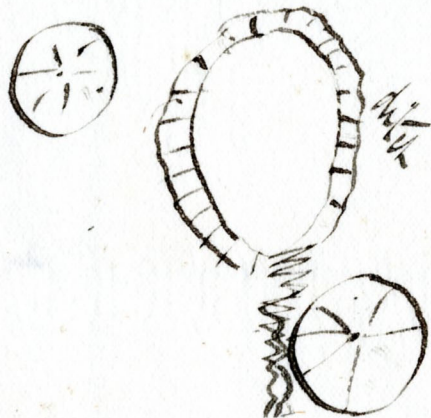

My dear Sir,

Will you be good enough
to indicate to me to what work I should
consult to distinguish (A) between pre-
historic Barrows and Earth-pits -
(B) the distinction between Prehistoric,
British, Roman, Roman-British and
Saxon Earthworks.

Although generally interested in the ques-
tion, my more immediate view as to dis-
tinguishing knowledge is that there are in this point
some matters I wish to explore, and do
not consider myself sufficiently an expert to
do so without more knowledge.

They consist of an oval central mound
with a flat top and slightly raised lip, sur-
-rounded with a deep ditch, and out-worked
with six or seven smaller mounds - some-
thing like this rough plan, only with more



outworks, I think you.
