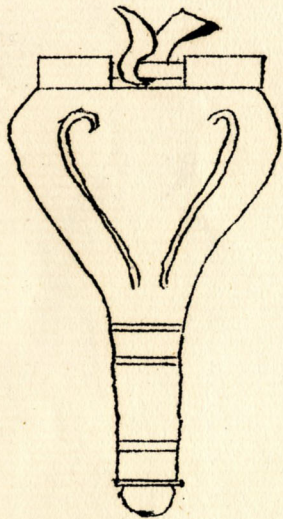

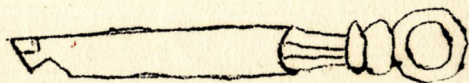
ROMAN LOCK PLATE HASP AND KEY.

Key Ring.



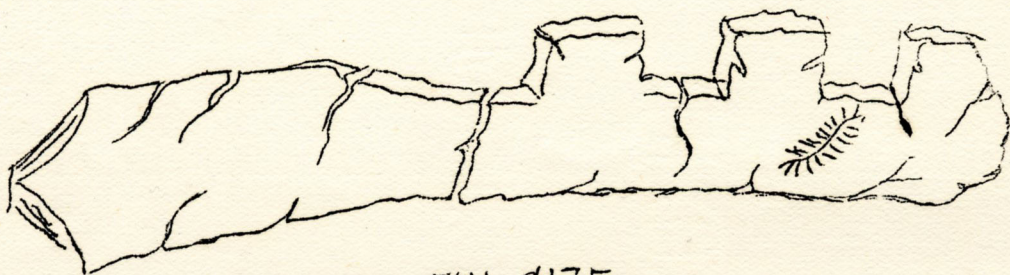
