Dear General Pitt. Rivers,

- plan of the Roman House which you
are excavating at Iwerne? A friend
of mine, who is very much interested

hear whether he has seen anything like

that plastered chamber in any
buildings he has been examining
in Rome or the neighbourhood.

I am enclosing a small photograph
which I had taken of a fibula, found
~~at~~ in my late parish, Bude. It
was found about a foot below the turf
on some open downs by the sea, in a
very exposed position, where one would
scarcely expect a building could have
stood.

I expect you have finished your

excavation at Iwerne for the winter.

I hope you have not taken any harm
from the cold weather which came on
a week or two ago.
