Judging from the reproductions I should say the 3.F coin No. 4 plate 258 is of Gallienus & No. 5 plate 312 a 2.F of Vespasian or Titus. In the latter case however the appearance or feel of the piece of metal is all important. I should be glad if you could send me those 2 coins for inspection also that on pl. 315 which from the stamp of the outline of the head I take to be <sup>conversus of</sup> sep. Rev. I suppose that it is stated to be a 3.F however.
