I went to see Sir Richard Taylor last night to decide about my going into his service as Coachman when he informed me that the character he had had from you was not satisfactory as you had to discharge me through drink; which I know I was wrongly accused but Bailey told me before I left that you said you would give me a good character

one to trouble you and
you have prevented me
from a good situation
but I should be greatly
thankful to you if you

me trying for any situation
but after living with you
ten years in all I thought
you would have looked
the matter over.
