of the old oak for ornamenting
the altar - but this is of Charles II
period, consequently it is not of much
use - I made a plan of a

small ~~recess~~ recess, into an angle
of the wall, near the tower, which
is not unlike the one in the room
at King James - This ~~recess~~
or whatever it wd be called, has two
small ~~holes~~ ^{loopholes} & a stone seat with
a hole in it, which looks as if it
had been used as a closet.
