SIR,

May I venture to call your especial attention to the SCIENTIFIC RELIEF FUND OF THE ROYAL SOCIETY, the immense value of which, to men of science or their families in need of temporary aid, must be apparent to all.

The Fund dates from the year 1859, and the Council of the Royal Society takes charge of any sums contributed to it, and invests them, applying the interest in grants for the relief of such scientific men or their families as may from time to time require and deserve assistance. These grants are, however, only made on the recommendation of a Committee which investigates the cases, and applications for relief cannot be entertained except on the recommendation of one of the following societies, viz., the Astronomical, Chemical, Geographical, Geological, Linnean, Royal, and Zoological Societies.

Since January, 1861, when the first grant was made, the total number of grants has been ninety-four, and the total sum distributed £4,615.

The capital amount invested at the present time is about £6,500, and while its income is only about £250, the demands upon the Fund in 1884 amounted to £450, while last year £275 only was expended in relief, the produce of the Fund not permitting of more extended grants.

An unexpected opportunity of largely increasing the usefulness of the Fund has lately arisen through a munificent offer of SIR WILLIAM ARMSTRONG, C.B., F.R.S. It is that SIR WILLIAM will contribute a sum of £6,500 to the Scientific Relief Fund on certain conditions, the principal of which is

that an equal sum be subscribed by the Fellows and other friends of science within the present year, thus raising the total amount of the Fund to about £20,000. Subscribers will, however, be at liberty to pay their Subscriptions by instalments extending over two years.

The Fellows of the Royal Society have responded liberally to the appeal that has been made to them, and I venture to hope that the Fellows of other Societies, who are equally interested in the welfare of the Fund, will come to their aid in such a manner that within the time prescribed by SIR WILLIAM ARMSTRONG, a sufficient sum will have been raised to entitle us to claim the fulfilment of his generous offer.
