who bought it at the sale

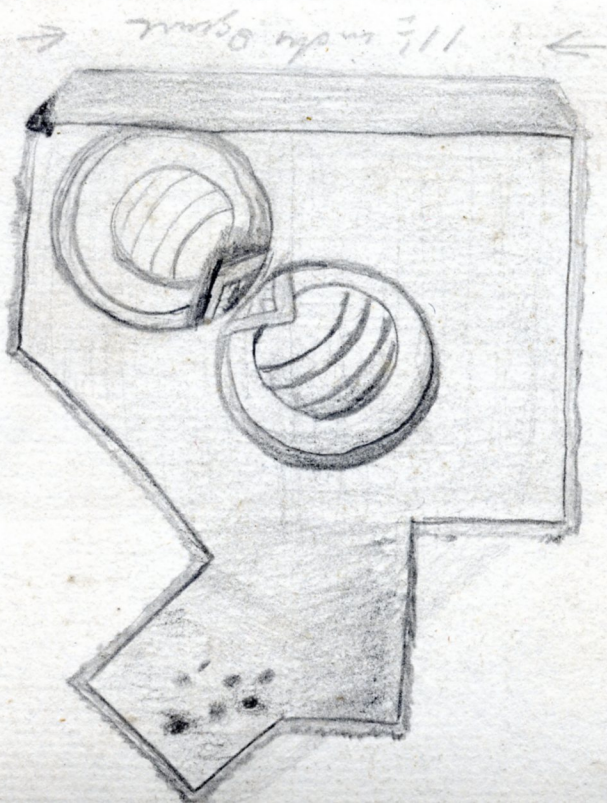
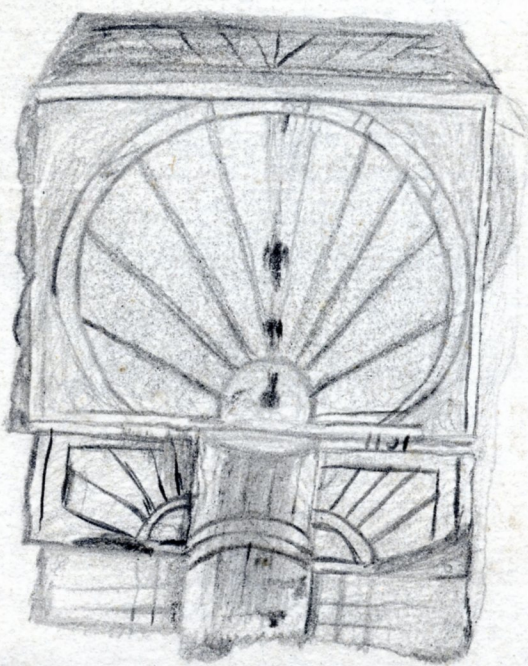
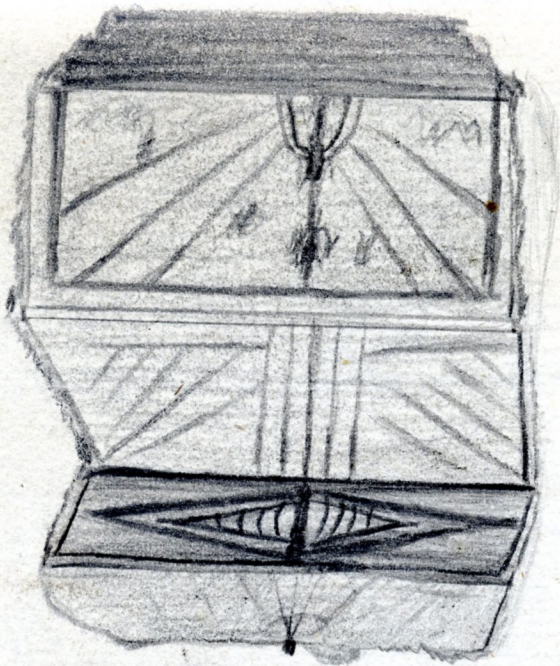
of the finders effects.
