Dear General Pitt Rivers

I am very much ashamed
of myself not to have answered
your letter before about the plate
of pottery found at Rushmore.
The fact is that I unslaid the
plate and have been trying to
find it - but hitherto with
no success - and I therefore cannot
answer some of your questions -
I think however that I saw
the piece of pottery with a kind

of ~~enigmas~~ lathe cut ornament
upon it and a slight glaze &
there seems little doubt that the
appearance of it is in favour of
its being Roman - The piece
with curved lines  are
very much like the piece found
by Sir H. Dyden at Hunsbury
Camp near Northampton - &
also like some I saw found
in Kent, and with which were
found some Late Celtic
things we have at the Brit.
Mus.

This is all I can think of

without your letter & plate
but I need not say I
shall be most happy to
give you any further
notes I can.
