## Diocesan Church House Building Fund.

Since July, 1886, when the last Account was printed, the Donations, paid or promised, have amounted to £1059 9s. 2d.

The Bazaar in August, 1887, yielded a net result of £617 13s. 2d., making a total of £1677 2s. 4d., reducing the Debt to £2288 19s. 6d.

The Freehold of the Property was conveyed to the Diocesan Board of Finance in July, 1887.

In order to pay off this heavy debt upon the Institution the Committee are anxious to increase the list of Subscribers, and at the same time to relieve the Fund by lessening the interest for which it is annually liable.

It has been resolved, therefore, to invite persons to lend the money in sums of £10 and upwards, with or without interest at 2½ per cent., to be repaid by annual drawings.
