measurements of the Rotherly skulls.
The paper I contemplate for

some skulls & skeletons from
the parts of Wiltshire some of

Skulls are in the Surge Museum
Museum in the possession of Mr.
Cunningham. They are all from
Dartmoor (Long). I propose to com-
pare the results of their measurement
with those you obtained from your
Villars. I find that the stature
of the people buried in Bowles
Dartmoor is exactly the same
as that of the Woodcut's people.
I am working up the results
of the Anthropological Laboratory
last year at Manchester
and would like to see you
about the arrangements
for the Bath one. If you

to call.
