It interests me the more that
I have just been investiga-
ting the remains of no less
than 3 "Pict's houses", and
one so called "Castle" on the
north Coast of Sutherland-
shire. They were all level
with the ground, but one
contained a very curious

underground passage, lined
with slab, 20 or 30 ft long
opening on the face of the
cliff.

I take the liberty of en-
closing rough outline of
a flint, just dug up a
few hundred yards from
my house. It is much
the best we have found here
and the only one that gives
the mixture of chipping &

grinding down.
