I suppose that since your ^{report} ~~papers~~ of June 1875 you
have been there and found that the remains
of pits outside the Camp have probably used
them in great quantities. (See Note p 369)

Camps on Highdown & Harrow Hills if so did
you find evidences of pits that satisfied you the
manufacture of implements was carried on there
also.
