of stone before, I think it wd
be very difficult to find anyone
but a practical mason who
wd guarantee the difference
between the various beds of
Portland stone that have been
newly dressed, & I doubt here
if he wd know without cutting
it. The Roade bed is the
one that has marked
differences - Of course in a
short time, as in this case
the weather finds out which
is the wrong bed.


