My dear Sir,

I am very sorry to hear that you have been laid by. I did not miss your coming to see the collection, as I have not been in London for two months now, owing to a bad cold, &c. So nothing has been distributed yet. From Medinet there are only some small samples of colours. From Tell el Amarna (XVIII dyn) there are colours, glazes, glazed pendants & moulds for making them, glass working <sup>hints</sup>, & Egyptian pottery; beside sculptures, of which there are

plenty of small pieces in different materials. I shall be glad to put you by a selection of all these, as technical specimens, if you wish for them.

All the important pieces will go to the Ashmolean as a whole series.

You may kindly return your first two volumes on Cranborne Chase, and I should much value the other on Bokerly & Wansdyke.
