At the ANNUAL MEETING of the Society, held at LEEDS, on 14th December, 1892, a recommendation of the Council was adopted "That the Society undertake the exploration of certain Prehistoric Remains in Upper Wharfedale; that a subscription be raised for this purpose; and that the gentlemen whose names are given above, constitute a Committee to carry this resolution into effect, with power to add to their number."

The remains are extensive and comprise earthworks, several tumuli, and other objects which are expected to prove of exceptional interest. Their significance, however, is at present by no means fully understood.
