Dear Mr. Mansel-Pleydell,

have no sympathy; or rather, I am
strongly opposed to them.

It is only fair under the circum-
stances that I should give the
names of one or two references:
the Rev. Canon Dyke, Comptor
Abbas Rectory, Shaftesbury, for
whom I have often done duty,
and the Rev. Dr. Cunningham
Geikie (Old Park, Bournemouth)
a well-known Broad Church writer
("The Life of Christ", "Hours with
the Bible," &c.) would I am
sure answer any reasonable
question about me.
