My dear Sir!

I am very much obliged to
You for the very interesting
book you were so kind to
send me. I have been very pleased
to read it.

I am sorry that I have not
been able to give you an
answer belonging the
Nydam boat. When I returned
to Denmark, I could not
go directly to Copenhagen
and when I arrived I
did not find Mr. Stephensen
who made the model of
the Nydam boat in the
Museum. Now this time
I found him. He made
not the model alone, when

he made it; he only directed
the fabrication; and the
man who worked it under
his inspection, is not alive.
But Mr. Stephensen thinks
that he will be able to get
an other, who could make
a new model under his
direction. But he has not
found one yet. He thinks
it will cost 150-180 Kroner
£9-£10. He should prefer
one, who was accustomed
to make models of ships
and boats. As soon as I
am getting better information
and an habile man has
been found I shall write
again.
