I have just returned from Reading where I saw Mr Wheeler himself. He told me that a letter to me was posted this morning which I shall receive by this evening post and from his why he read out to me that to fit the parts which were loose to repair defects & to clean the two monuments will cost about £5. I am very greatly relieved to find that there is nothing defective about the foundations.

& that there will be no need to  
unbuild - is there such a word? -  
that fine monument of Rev W  
Pitt.

May I ask you kindly to give  
me leave to put the work in  
hand as soon as possible. The top  
of the big monument & two slender  
on that of Mr Geo Pitt are so  
loose that the high winds or the  
vibration of the bells might  
bring them down.

If you are kind enough to  
defray the expense so let it be  
But if not we are here very  
proud of our monuments & I  
have no doubt that the necessary  
funds can be raised locally

as soon as ever we have received  
your permission to begin
