Suzey on the Rhine. They are good specimens
& there is a notion that there was a
manufactory there in Roman times

2 Roman pots from Cologne
interesting because they are very like
similar ones made in Britain. one
is a pretty shape & is just like a number
one in the British Museum. They represent
very well the provincial ware of the
Romans & their hand does indeed the

Rhine were to each other in Roman times.

3 A curious wooden disc with a man standing
on one side and a unusual party on the other
probably early 17th century & used for stamping
cakes.

4. 2 Pots which I think curious one of the

form which was used at Cologne in early times and has
unusual patterns. They are very seldom perfect. The other

is of broken ware with oak leaves etc in relief. You
will see how the pot of each may be exactly the same.
