In reply to yr. letter just received I beg to inform you that the Anthropometric Committee have discontinued the collection of statistics of breathing capacity.

The only instrument ever used by them for that purpose was one of Coxeter's bag Spirometer which it was found necessary to have enlarged, so as to contain, I think, 350 or 400 cubic inches. These instruments however are not

now in a good state of repair.
